2. Payments via PayPal

Payments via PayPal are simple, cost effective and we get short term access. They are particularly good for donations made outside of the UK.

Proceed as follows:

1. Log into your PayPal account
2. Select "My PayPal"
3. Select "Pay or send money"
4. Select "Send money to friends or family"
5. Enter "charity@waterberrylodge.com" as the e-mail address
6. Enter contribution amount
7. Enter optional message
8. Verify contribution amount including 5% PayPal fee
9. Select "Send Money Now"
